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If this recommendation is approved, student transportation fees will increase for the 2004-2005 school year. The recommended fee schedule for the 2004-2005 school year will generate \$5,528,000. This revenue, along with provincial funding of \$17,273,000 and \$356,000 from the 2003-2004 projected carry forward surplus, will balance with the projected 2004-2005 transportation expenditure of \$23,157,000.

Background

The extent to which student transportation fees increase or decrease annually is dependent on:

- 1. the level of provincial funding,
- 2. expenditures related to the district's cost of purchasing Edmonton Transit student bus passes from the city,
- 3. the number of students purchasing public transit passes,
- 4. the number of students and type of programs supported by yellow bus service, and
- 5. the cost of school bus contracts.

Costs have been steadily increasing over the past year with the addition of six new buses to alleviate over-crowded buses and to reduce ride times for routes that were excessively long. The district experienced an increase of 215 special needs students requiring transportation, an additional 350 students riding Edmonton Transit. Student Transportation is also now managing the transportation for Elves Child Development Centre. Plans are in place to maximize the current fleet of buses without adding more in the coming year. The carry forward surplus for 2004-2005 is reduced from \$1,243,042 in 2003-2004 to \$356,000 in 2004-2005.

As a result of successful negotiations with the bus contractors, the yellow bus contract rates will increase 1 percent and Edmonton Transit monthly bus passes for students will increase on September 1, 2004 from \$41.00 to \$42.00.

The projected revenue includes a provincial grant rate increase of 2 percent effective in the 2004-2005 school year.
