## RECOMMENDATION

That the locally developed course **Marine Biology 25** be approved for use in Edmonton Public Schools.

## Background and Rationale:

In 1998 a locally developed course entitled Marine Biology 15 was approved for use in the district as a 3 credit course. The course was intended to provide an opportunity for students interested in Biology and the world's oceans to begin to learn about this topic in a more indepth way than provided for in provincially approved courses.

In the course of offering the Marine Biology 15 curriculum, some weaknesses have been identified and have been addressed in a revision to the course. The main revision is to reclassify the course as a grade 11 or 25 level course. Grade 10 students simply did not have the necessary background to take full advantage of the curriculum contained in the program of studies. Therefore the amended course has Science 10 as a pre-requisite and Biology, Physics or Chemistry 20 as a co-requisite.
