





Superintendent review meetings and reviews of central departments will be at the Centre for Education.</li> <li>The format of the school review meetings will be as follows: <ul> <li>a) The meeting will not exceed one and one-half hours for groups of four schools and two hours for groups of five or more.</li> <li>b) The agenda will include: <ul> <li>i. Welcome and introductions by the hosting principal.</li> <li>ii. The trustee chair will outline the process for the meeting. (3 min.)</li> <li>iii. Each principal will present in turn and begin by introducing any staff, students, or parents in attendance.</li> <li>iv. The principal will then highlight (5 minutes) year two of their revised 2005-2008 plans.</li> <li>v. After each presentation there will be opportunity for questions from trustees. (5 minutes)</li> <li>Although principals will not involve parents, students, or staff in the presentation, there will be opportunity for anyone present at the meeting to ask questions or comment on each school's plan.</li> <li>vi. Other (15 minutes) - other questions or items for discussion identified by trustees, principals, or others present at the meeting.</li> <li>c) Minutes of the meetings will be kept, including a record of questions and responses. 


