INFORMATION

Major maintenance of and minor upgrades to district facilities are accomplished through the district's Major Maintenance Plan (MMP) which is block funded by the government Infrastructure Maintenance Program (IMP). The IMP is one source of available funding for the maintenance of facilities. The funding sources are:

- Operational funds which are allocated from the operating budget of the district and are determined by government formula under the plant operations and maintenance (PO&M) category.
- Infrastructure Maintenance Program funds.
- Capital Project funds. Capital projects are provincially funded and address either essential or general upgrades to school buildings. These projects are approved on a case by case basis and are drawn from the district's capital plan.

The funding sources for a six-year period with funding for 2005-2006 being projected are shown in the graph in Appendix I. The 2005 IMP allocation from Alberta Infrastructure has not, as yet, been announced. The 2005 Major Maintenance Plan is therefore based on last year's allocation of \$5,808,649. Should there be a change in the allocation the plan will be modified by either adding or deleting projects.

Projects to be included in the Major Maintenance Plan are identified for consideration by receiving input from schools, facilities staff and regulatory agencies. The need and requests for school improvement projects continue to exceed available funding. The plan, therefore, reflects the highest district need. The priorities and categories of projects have been developed with input from principals, and have been found to assist principals with recognizing both district needs and the comparative needs from school to school. The development of the major maintenance plan has involved over 84 principals in the last eleven years, and will continue to rely on principal involvement in the development of the plan and prioritization of projects.

To ensure that all schools have the opportunity to provide input regarding their school's needs a procedure is included in the budget process. Information is provided to each school identifying scheduled/approved capital projects in that school. In addition, schools have been provided with information regarding the facility needs they previously identified. Schools have been requested to review their needs, add or delete projects, and prioritize the projects from the school's perspective on an annual basis.

Renewal of major building elements such as re-roofing are dealt with on a life-cycle replacement and condition assessment basis, thereby distributing the financial obligation over a number of years. This approach ensures that the district's physical assets are reasonably maintained through an annual financial commitment of 4.8 - 5.2 million. The funds remaining from the IMP block grant can then be directed towards other eligible needs, such as physical upgrades to enhance educational program delivery.

The 2005 Major Maintenance Plan has been reviewed to establish whether previously identified projects are consistent with current priorities. The resultant 2005 Major Maintenance Plan is attached (Appendix II). Projects are identified and listed in accordance with district categories and priorities. As well, an amount is included for emergent projects, for example, the replacement of failed hot water heaters and furnaces.

Highlights

- Facilities Services has centrally managed funding to continue the air system maintenance program which is designed to improve indoor air quality through a two stage cleaning of air systems. The first stage addressed the cleaning of air coils, reheat coils and univents which are often the main contributors to decreased air quality. Assessment of air quality and stage two includes an airflow and where necessary, air-ducting systems will be cleaned. The program is being carried out on a scheduled basis. Stage one has been completed. The program is at no cost to the schools. This is year one of stage two of this program. Stage two will commence in September 2005.
- The asbestos management program to enhance safe work procedures for district staff and assist administrators with hazardous materials strategies related to on-going inspection, monitoring and training was commenced in 2001. The asbestos abatement projects within the 2005 MMP are a continuation of the program.
- The 2005 MMP continues the partnership with EPCOR for the relighting program for schools. The intent is to improve student learning environments and reduce energy costs. Fifty-four schools have been completed to date.
- In order to assist the district in the management of district assets, a five-year life-cycle replacement program is included with the MMP. This program provides information to the schools that will assist them in making decisions relative to maintenance expenditures and to allow the schools to undertake longer term planning for the management of the building (Appendix III). The actual projects may vary depending on government funding levels and changes in district priorities.



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
