INFORMATION

In response to provincial requirements for an annual three-year education plan, the three-year education plan for the district (Appendix I) has been developed based on the district's budget planning process. The plan describes the district framework for achieving superb results from all students. It highlights major district strategies proposed by schools and central services decision units through the plans already reviewed by trustee sub-committees.

The major changes from the district's previous three year plan are format and breadth of strategies and measures. Alberta Learning has increased the number of provincial and local strategies and measures required.

As required, the plan reflects a Grades 1 to 12 perspective. It includes the three board approved measures and district satisfaction survey measures that parallel provincial survey measures. This provides a balance between local and provincial accountability measures.
