## INFORMATION

Rates charged to schools and central department decision units for services provided by cost recovery decisions units, and fees charged to staff, students, parents, and the community are revised annually by the administration. All fees are reviewed in accordance with board policy INB.BP – School Assessed Fees, and administrative regulation INB.AR – School Assessed Fees, to ensure that no charges are included for instruction or for the use of instructional materials other than for music instrument rental at junior and senior high schools and textbook rentals at the senior high schools.

The rates and fees for 2007-2008 provided in Appendix I have been approved by the superintendent. Sections are highlighted where there is a rate change or a new service being offered for 2007-2008. A rationale is provided for changes in rates. These rates reflect known increases and any further changes may be incorporated in the fall and applied retroactive to September 1, 2007.

Student transportation fees are not included in Appendix I. They will be reported to board at a later date.

The district has been directed to charge and collect GST on all after-hours rentals. This will be calculated by Financial Services and added to the invoice being sent to the group. When Rental Services coordinates the paid rentals for schools, they will forward the request for billing to Financial Services with instructions to code revenue to the school. The GST collected will be forwarded to Revenue Canada by Financial Services.

RATIONALE: The increase to hourly custodial fees adjusts the rates to reflect current collective agreement settlements.

Coaching visits for balanced literacy include demonstration teaching and, often, lesson planning. One-quarter hour of lesson planning has been added for each  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours of coaching/demonstration teaching in recognition of consultants' preparation time, and which is often individualized to each teacher's expectations. This underestimates the actual time involved.

RATIONALE: Staffing cost increases resulting from the 2006-2007 Teacher's Collective Agreement, for Support Staff, and for grid movement for Exempt Staff, have led to the increase in the hourly rates. Other rates based on the hourly rate have accordingly been increased by an approximate 2.5%.
