RECOMMENDATION

That the following schedule noting bus pass fees for the 2012-2013 school year be approved, to be effective August 2012.

BACKGROUND

Student Transportation Services is funded from two sources; provincial transportation grants and student transportation fees. A modest increase in provincial funding will be received in 2012-2013. No increase to bus pass fees is being proposed.

In considering the proposed 2012-2013 fee schedule, the following is noted:

- The projected overall increase to the provincial transportation grant is estimated to be six per cent for the 2012-2013 school year.
- The projected overall increase in cost for transportation services is estimated to be four per cent for the 2012-2013 school year.

The 2012-2013 funding rates help to align provincial funding with the current market pricing for transportation services. No expenditure of carry forward surplus funds is expected in order to offset a revenue shortfall.

RELATED FACTS

Administration continues to work closely with the other metro jurisdictions and Alberta Education to secure a sustainable, predictable funding formula. Retained carry forward funds will be utilized to facilitate any transitions in funding and:

- achieve additional design efficiencies in the transportation service delivery model;
- implement service-oriented improvements to ensure student safety and maximize the ability of school staff to focus on student needs and achievement; and
- accommodate any additional service demands resulting from ongoing development of new communities.

The extent to which student Transportation fees increase or decrease annually is dependent on:

- 1. the level of provincial funding;
- 2. expenditures related to the District's cost of purchasing Edmonton Transit student bus passes from the city;
- 3. the number of students purchasing public transit passes;
- 4. the number of schools serviced;
- 5. the number of students and type of programs supported by yellow bus service, including service to new communities;
- 6. the cost of school bus contracts;
- 7. the un-funded and non-statutory services offered by the District; and
- 8. the compliance to regulations and eligibility procedures.
