INFORMATION

The Leadership in Languages: Leadership Development Project was initiated by a team of consultants from Consulting Services to support the development of leadership skills and knowledge in second language programming.

Fifteen district teachers representing six languages across both elementary and secondary programs attended after-school sessions and completed assignments and projects including classroom intervisitations, analyses and critiques of Western Canadian Protocol Common Curriculum Frameworks, creation of community contact resource databases, design and delivery of inservices, and personal leadership action plans.

This program was highly successful and will be offered again in a weeklong summer institute format to teachers and language program leaders in Edmonton Public Schools and other school jurisdictions throughout Alberta.
