BACKGROUND

On May 10, 2011 delegation spokespersons, Ms. Roxanne Felix and Mr. Matt Hundert, representatives of the SAAIRCY sub-committee, appeared before the Board to request a letter (or other form of support, i.e., resolution) to support their campaign that advocates for Government of Canada to:

- 1. Immediately cancel all outstanding refugee transportation and pre-entry medical loan debt.
- 2. Cease seeking repayment of the refugee transportation and pre-entry medical costs for new Government Assisted and Privately Sponsored refugees coming to Canada.
- 3. Undertake these actions without reducing the number of refugees who are allowed to resettle in Canada.

NEXT STEPS

If the recommendation is approved the Administration will draft a letter of support for the Board Chair's signature.
