## RECOMMENDATION

That the attached schedule noting bus pass fees for the 20112012 school year be approved, effective August 2011.

Student Transportation Services is funded from two sources; provincial transportation grants and student transportation fees. No increase in provincial funding will be received in 20112012.

In considering the proposed 2011-2012 fee schedule, which represents no increase to student bus pass fees, the following should be noted:

- The recent Request for Proposal generated a new service contract resulting in a positive response and is expected to yield an approximate 2 per cent decrease in overall budgeted yellow bus costs for 2011-2012.
- ETS fees will increase to $\$ 65.55$ per month for 2011-2012 which represents an increase of 3.5 per cent.

At the beginning of the 2011-2012 school year, Student Transportation Services will have a current/carry-forward surplus of approximately $\$ 3.5$ million. In order to avoid an increase to bus pass rates and offset the effects of service increases, $\$ 800,000$ of the current/carryforward surplus will be applied to the 2011-2012 budget plan. The remaining carry-forward surplus of $\$ 2.7$ million will be retained for future use in order to maintain current service levels and number of yellow bus routes.

Administration continues to work closely with the other metro jurisdictions and Alberta Education to secure a sustainable, predictable funding formula. Retained carry forward funds will be utilized to facilitate any transitions in funding and to:

- achieve additional design efficiencies in the transportation service delivery model;
- continue to implement service-oriented improvements to ensure student safety and maximize the ability of school staff to focus on student needs and achievement;
- accommodate any additional service demands resulting from ongoing development of new communities.

The extent to which student transportation fees increase or decrease annually is dependent on:

- the level of provincial funding;
- expenditures related to the District's cost of purchasing Edmonton Transit student bus passes from the city;
- the number of students purchasing public transit passes;
- the number of schools serviced;
- the number of students and type of programs supported by yellow bus service, including service to new communities;
- the cost of school bus contracts;
- the unfunded and non-statutory services offered by the District; and
- compliance to regulations and eligibility procedures.

## Annual Pass

- Paid in full September 2011.
- A specific pass will be available for the annual yellow pass. For ETS, a new pass needs to be given out each month.


## Edmonton Transit Passes

- Valid for unlimited travel on Edmonton Transit. Students must be enrolled in either an Edmonton Public elementary, junior or senior high school.
- Replacement passes are available at the school which the student is registered or through either the ETS Customer Information Office at Churchill LRT station (99 Street and 102A Avenue) or the ETS Online Store.
- Mutilated passes will be replaced at no charge if the student turns in an identifiable remnant. The mutilated pass must be returned by the school to Financial Services.
