3. That the following locally developed courses be deleted:

Deaf Cultural Studies 15-25-35 Chinese (Mandarin) Language and Culture 15-25-35 German Language Arts 15-25-35 German Language Arts k-9 (bilingual program)

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Background: Locally developed courses must be approved and renewed every three years by the developing board. In the case of high school courses, Alberta Learning also renews courses on a three-year cycle.

Locally developed courses are permitted and governed by Alberta Learning policies. All courses developed align to these policies including such guidelines as the following:

- courses are completed within the year they are started
- a certificated teacher is required for instruction
- unique hours of instruction are required for each course
- waiver provision does not apply to locally developed courses

Courses renewed at this time are in use at schools across the district.

Courses acquired from other districts, e.g. Musical Theatre, are also updated every three years with revised course outlines and permission letters from authoring districts.

T.E.A.M. (Together Everyone Achieves More) Leadership is a locally developed course acquired from Calgary Board of Education to meet needs identified by district high schools.

Three new courses are submitted to meet needs of district schools. For example, J. Percy Page is planning to offer Exercise Science 35 for developing healthy students and for career exploration in the sport and recreation fields.

Deaf Cultural Studies is no longer used in the district due to improvements in the American Sign Language Arts curriculum.

Chinese (Mandarin) Language and Culture and German Language Arts are now provincial courses and no longer required as locally developed courses.

Copies of the courses are available for viewing in the Trustees' Reading Room.
