## **INFORMATION**

In June of 2003-2004, Communications was asked to produce an updated *O Canada* video in both English and French for public board meetings.

Tonight's bilingual rendition of *O Canada* (D major) was realized through a collaborative effort between the staff and students of Centre High, two district enrichment choirs, the district music consultant and communications staff. This particular *O Canada* is one of three versions of the national anthem included on the video. The other versions are in English only.

This fall, five Centre High students were responsible for shooting video footage that showcased teaching and learning as well as students and staff in district schools.
