The Capital Region has a budget of \$136 million. At present the Capital Region has 4,000 active cases of children in care at an average cost of \$30,000 per case (based on a provincial average). The Capital region is at the top of the list in terms of the funds allocated. The committee is examining the delivery of children's services in other provinces.
