Diane Fischer – Curriculum Coordinator, International Baccalaureate Program - Harry Ainlay

Diane Fischer exemplifies excellence in the classroom and in the support she provides for both students and teachers in the International Baccalaureate Program at Harry Ainlay. She oversees the ongoing professional training of staff, the administration of the requirements of the IB program, the academic progress and emotional balance of students. She is a strong supporter the district's Focus on Supporting Teaching and Learning initiative and the school's instructional focus of reading comprehension.
