INFORMATION

As a result of the Memorandum of Understanding signed between the Governments of Alberta and Spain, a joint project to create a Spanish Language Arts (K-12) curriculum has been undertaken. The partners in the project, which is to provide Spanish curriculum to support the International Spanish Academies, are Edmonton Public Schools (Project Manager), Calgary Board of Education, Alberta Learning and the University of Calgary.

The curriculum, when completed, will become a provincial curriculum, the development of which has been undertaken as a contract from Alberta Learning. A committee of the partners has been established and has already conducted a very productive week of meetings in Calgary during the week of November 13th through 17th. A second week of work will be conducted in Edmonton during the week of December 11th through 15th. It is anticipated that the draft of the curriculum will be completed by January 1, 2001.

The draft document will be vetted by teachers and other stakeholders with a final draft being available by April 1, 2001. The curriculum will then be piloted in the International Spanish Academies during the 2001-2002 school year.
