Former Trustee Kay Chernowski passed away February 5, 2002 at the age of seventy-eight years.

Mrs. Chernowski began her teaching career with Edmonton Public Schools in 1958 at Mount Pleasant school, and also taught at Dovercourt, Glenora, and Clara Tyner Schools. She then served as a consultant in Consulting Services and supervisor in Early Childhood Services. Mrs. Chernowski opened Menisa School and served as its principal until her retirement in 1986.

In 1995 she was elected to the Board of Trustees where she served until 1998.

Former Trustee Chernowski is survived by her husband John Chimich; daughter and son-in-law, Kim and Mark Mathias; and their daughter, Nicole Katherine.
