ISSUE

The following information was requested: provide ideas and options for a district award that recognizes outstanding teaching in the areas of Social Studies and Language Arts. Also provide a list of suitable partners that the District could approach to sponsor this award (similar to the APEGGA Teachers' Award Program for Science and Math).

BACKGROUND

The Association of Professional Engineers, Geologists and Geophysicists of Alberta (APEGGA) represent a large group of professionals whose primary occupational activity is directly related to math and sciences. Through their Education Foundation awards, they recognize the inspired teaching of core skills and knowledge in math and science.

CURRENT SITUATION

There are no similar associations to APEGGA in Alberta whose members' occupation is primarily based on the disciplines of social studies or language arts teaching. Numerous organizations exist who reward the outcome or product of social studies and language arts knowledge and skills. These organizations are primarily literary and reward an individual's work product, not their teaching.
