### **INFORMATION**

The purpose of this report is to provide the Board of Trustees with an update on the status of the new Riverbend-Terwillegar high school project.

# The Project Management Team

Cohos Evamy has been appointed the architectural firm for the Riverbend – Terwillegar High School Project. Project team discussions to address initial stages of the project, which include components such as site plans, conceptual design, facility requirements and program needs, are now underway between administration and Cohos Evamy.

The administration has established a three member high school principal advisory team to provide input and information that is needed for planning in the design phase of the project.

A comprehensive communication plan will be developed for the duration of the project beginning early in the design stage.

The project will be managed through a Steering Committee. As well, a Design Committee and Construction Committee have been established to provide input into the project. A Principal Advisory Team will also provide input into the project until such time as a principal for the school is designated.

The roles of the various committees are outlined as follows-

- Management Steering Committee
  - ensure adherence to overall project objectives and timelines
- Design Committee
  - gather user, stakeholder, regulatory data
  - define project parameters
  - formulate design solutions

- Principal Advisory Team
  - during design phase-provide district high school pedagogical, operational, cultural terms of reference, guidance and expertise to the design committee
  - sign off on the education portion of the design of the school
- Construction Committee
  - manage construction contract administration
  - coordinate final-fit up and move-in

# Site Information

The City of Edmonton Community Services hosted a joint Value Search Exploratory Workshop to explore the ideas, challenges and opportunities of integrating the proposed South West Recreation Complex with the new high school. The attendees involved in the workshop included representatives from the City of Edmonton, Edmonton Public Schools, Edmonton Catholic Schools and Terwillegar-Riverbend Advisory Council. The outcome of this workshop will be a joint communiqué / Memorandum of Understanding outlining ongoing cooperation of all parties to pursue integration.

The administration and the City of Edmonton officials have been working cooperatively to integrate the school with the proposed South West Recreational Center. Numerous meetings have been held with the City of Edmonton and community stakeholders. The district's ability to contribute is severely restricted by the limited budget for the project and timelines; however, administration is working to maximize the potential for community use, keeping in mind the first priority is to build a high school.

The City of Edmonton is proposing a comprehensive re-design of their site and the collector roadway to allow their facility to move closer to the high school. The school site remains unchanged with the school being built on the school site. Administration supports this proposal as it enhances the integration and improves the roadway. By relocating the road around the recreation center the road is lengthened and will reduce the attractiveness for non-school /arena traffic and shortcutting. (Appendix II, Appendix III)

If the proposal proceeds, as it is anticipated it will, a revision to the Area Structure Plan will be required as well as a bylaw amendment. This will take time but a delay to the project is not anticipated.

Administration is conducting site investigation work required to initiate construction on the school building site. A geotechnical investigation of the soils is required for the architects to facilitate the design of the building.

### Preliminary Project Schedule

Cohos Evamy has prepared a preliminary project schedule (Appendix IV). The schedule identifies the various tasks involved to complete the project, including duration of the task, start and finish dates. The tasks are also separated in sub-tasks outlining the process.

The Design Stage is currently underway. The project is scheduled for tender in January 2007 with school opening September 2008. In order for the school to open in September 2008 the project must be tendered not later than January, 2007.

### Next Steps

Next steps in this project will involve a consultation plan and schedule that will include district staff and the public (Appendix V). The upcoming tasks and timelines in the initial planning stage of this project include:

Ongoing Discussions and Communication with Principal Advisory Committee
Information will be gathered and shared through a three member high school principal committee that will engage in regularly scheduled meetings with Planning staff as they liaison with the project design committee. Information will be exchanged on a regular basis with the high school principal support group by this committee at support group meetings. The principal committee will be formed by March 14, 2006.

### Process to Name the School

The process to name the new high school is currently underway. Opportunities for input from the public, district staff and Trustees will be integrated into this process. The naming of the new high school will be completed by April 28, 2006.

## Assigning a Principal

The position of the principal for the new high school will be appointed by the Superintendent at a date to be determined.

# • Involvement of Focus Groups in Terms of Input to Preliminary Design


Planning staff will be coordinating meetings involving educational focus groups to provide input to the architectural team for the preliminary design. These focus groups will include district staff, high school principals and assistant principals, consultants, and school stakeholders. Trustees will advised of the dates of these upcoming meetings. These focus group meetings are anticipated to begin in April, 2006.

# Public Consultation on Proposed Attendance Boundaries




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
TAPPORTOR	Riverbend – Terwillegar Committee Structure
