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Background: Locally developed courses at all grade levels must be approved and renewed every three years by the Board of Trustees. Additionally, high school courses are reviewed and approved for offering by Alberta Education prior to implementation.

Locally developed courses are permitted and governed by Alberta Learning policies. All courses developed align to these policies including such guidelines as the following:

- courses are completed within the year they are started
- a certificated teacher is required for instruction
- unique hours of instruction are required for each course
- prerequisite courses may not be waived for locally developed courses

The following new locally developed courses have been created based on school requests to support programming at their school:

New Senior High Courses

Aviation 25-35 – to support Career Focused Education programming at Queen Elizabeth School

Beginner Music Choral 15 and **Beginner Music Instrument 15** – provides grade 10 students with an entry level music program in high school, given that existing courses require a junior high pre-requisite

Coaching 25 – replaces **Coaching 15** and aligns to new standards for National Coaching Certification Program

Forensic Science 35 – a rigorous course, designed at the request of high schools, with a required co-requisite of two 20 level sciences

Speech and Debate 15 – requested by Old Scona Academic to support the development of rhetoric and aligns to the Alberta Debate and Speech Association standards

Junior High Courses

Explorations in Film 9 - requested by junior high schools as a course to analyze detailed structure of film for art and communication

Learning to Lead 9 – requested by junior high schools to replace withdrawn CTS modules in Leadership

Locally developed courses to be deleted are the following: **Asia Pacific Rim Studies** – no longer used in the district

Information Technology in a Global Society – no longer used in the district

IB Sciences 15 and 35 level – IB students were only taking one of the science courses designated as 15, 25 or 35. All numbering referred to the same course and only referenced the grade level of the student. To create consistency in course names across the district, the courses will be retained as 25 level courses only (Biology 25 IB, Chemistry 25 IB, Physics 25 IB).
