On October 26, 2004 the board passed a motion requesting the administration to draft a questionnaire that could be submitted to each capital city candidate running for election on November 22, 2004 as a means of strengthening support for public education. Attached is the proposed questionnaire that addresses the following issues:

- Full day kindergarten in areas of high needs
- Access and coordination of health services to children
- Enhanced support for students with communication disorders
- Support for funding transportation to alternative programs
- Support for modernization of school facilities and new construction
- Collective bargaining

Subject to the approval of the recommendations, the questionnaire would be forwarded to the candidates electronically and responses would be posted on the district website. The purpose of this questionnaire is not to imply support for a particular candidate or party but to bring public attention to education issues.
