## **ISSUE**

The following information was requested: provide historical information regarding what factors may have caused the changes in the level of confidence of principals and central services staff in the Board of Trustees.

### **BACKGROUND**

Significant occurrences in 2007-2008 that may have impacted survey results:

- Edgar Schmidt was appointed as superintendent in the spring of that year. In January 2007, the former superintendent was released without cause from the Board.
- Two schools were closed: Ritchie and Woodcroft.
- The board set up an ad hoc committee to examine the effects of school closures.
- Multicultural task force was struck.
- Development of the Foundation.
- District budget had a 4.5 per cent increase to the base and a 3.0 per cent increase to all other allocations.
