Background

The policy Field Trips HICA.BP came into effect in 2003 and is scheduled for review.

Rationale

The intention of the review is to affirm the existing policy with minor editorial changes. The existing policy clearly articulates the position of the Board on the value of field trips, both locally, provincially and internationally. Further, the Board's position on the need to maintain student safety is clearly voiced.

The draft policy was available for feedback from the public on the District Web Survey from April 4 to May 9, 2011. Thirty-nine responses were received. The majority of the responses were very positive; with only eight individuals providing comments. These comments ranged in content from concerns on safe learning environments, staff and student ratios and suggestions related to wording of the policy.
