INFORMATION

In May 1999, 480 students from four district high schools (Harry Ainlay, McNally, Old Scona, and Ross Sheppard) wrote a total of 1409 I.B. examinations. This is an increase of 82 students and 174 examinations from 1998.

Table 1 provides a comparison of district results to world results from the May 1999 test administration. Information on the total number of students writing each examination is not available.

District averages for 1999 are higher than world averages for all courses in which district students participated.

In 1999, 99 out of 101 (98.0%) district I.B. diploma candidates were successful in obtaining their diploma. In 1998, 86 out of 88 students (97.7%) were successful in obtaining a diploma.

Appendices I and II provide longitudinal data from 1995-1999 of district I.B. examination mark averages. When comparing 1999 district results to the previous year, the district average is higher in Mathematics, Chemistry, French, German, and Japanese.

Table 2 provides school by school results for May 1999.
